THIS MUNICIPAL ORDER RELATES TO THE AUTHORIZATION FOR THE JEFFERSON COUNTY LEAGUE OF CITIES CABLE COMMISSION TO NEGOTIATE A FRANCHISE AGREEMENT FOR CABLE TELEVISION SERVICE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, the cable television franchise agreement entered into by the CITY with TKR CABLE OF GREATER LOUISVILLE or one of its predecessors is scheduled to expire between now and the end of 1997, and

WHEREAS, the CITY has recently become a member of the Jefferson County League of Cities Cable Commission (the "Cable Commission"), and

WHEREAS, the Cable Commission has the expertise in cable television matters which the CITY by itself lacks, and

WHEREAS, it makes sense fiscally and otherwise to work with other cities in Jefferson County to conduct cable television franchise negotiations,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED THAT the Cable Commission is authorized on behalf of the CITY to conduct any and all necessary negotiations and to enter any agreement with TKR CABLE OF GREATER LOUISVILLE ("TKR") for the purpose of renewing, modifying, denying or extending the franchise agreement entered into by the CITY with TKR or any predecessor thereof for the provision of cable television service to the residents of the CITY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDERED THAT the Cable Commission is authorized to negotiate and enter into a joint franchise agreement and to grant jointly a franchise on behalf of the CITY and any other units of government in Jefferson County who wish to jointly negotiate and enter into a joint agreement and to grant jointly a franchise.
