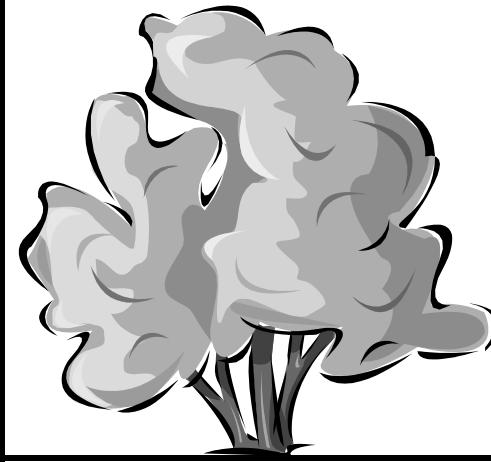

ORDINANCE NO. 2 SERIES 2014, BUDGET

CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY, ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2014, THROUGH JUNE 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015, ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

Whereas, an Annual Budget has been prepared and delivered to the City Commission; and,

Whereas, the City Commission has reviewed such budget proposal and made necessary modifications.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY THAT:

Section 1. The Annual Budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014 and ending June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015, is hereby adopted as follows:

Footnotes:

1. Tree Advisory Board/Committee – budget amount covers items such as Tree Inventory/maintenance of Public trees/shrubs by Tree Service Company, watering of Public Trees, office supplies, postage, and tree allotment funds. Unless specifically noted it is excluded.

Excludes mulch, chemicals, flowers, and tools of any type, as these will be included in the line item "Grounds".

2. Celebrations include all Special events [picnic, Halloween, Egg Hunt, Yard Sale].

3. Miscellaneous/Capital Improvements includes revised directory & postage, improvements in right of ways/easements such as plants/trees, limited allotment related to hazardous tree removal effecting public safety, and other capital improvement projects within the city boundaries agreed upon by a majority of the elected officials which are deemed beneficial to the city.

ORDINANCE NO. 1 SERIES 2014

CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY

THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE ON ALL REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY

Whereas, the City Commission of the City of Kingsley, Kentucky, has the authority pursuant to statute to enact Ordinances relating to the City, and

Whereas, it is required that the Ad Valorem tax rate be established and levied for the year July 1, 2014 through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015, on all real and personal property, for the general operating purposes of the City to cover fiscal year July 1, 2014 through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF KINGSLEY, KENTUCKY THAT:

Section 1. January 1, 2014 is hereby set as the assessment date for all real and personal property subject to City taxation within the boundaries of the City of Kingsley.

Section 2. The City Clerk and Treasurer are directed to obtain a true copy of the assessment of property within the corporate limits of the City of Kingsley, Kentucky and to make out tax bills and mail same. Each tax bill shall show the property and the improvements thereon separately, the name of the supposed owner [s] and the Ad Valorem tax rate, and the tax due to the fiscal year.

Section 3. Upon delivery of such bills, the Treasurer shall have the responsibility of supervising the collection of same, and all remittances shall be made to the City Treasurer, as required by law. Collection of delinquent taxes shall be made in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 4. The Ad Valorem tax rate for this year is fixed at \$0.33 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of property assessed for taxation. Such tax shall be due as follows:

Discount of 1 % if paid on or before July 31, 2014

Net bill if paid during August of 2014

Penalty if paid during September 2014 - 10%

Penalty if paid during October 2014 - 12%

After October 31, 2014, 12 % penalty PLUS 1 % interest PER MONTH, until paid.

Penalties are CUMULATIVE; if suit is initiated, then the taxpayer will pay COURT COSTS and ATTORNEY FEES.

Section 5. The tax payment shall be made as follows:

Section 6. The proceeds of this tax are to be used as follows: \$0.33 per One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) of valuation, being the entire amount of said tax plus interest or penalties collected thereon, for general operation of the City.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.
